UNLOCKING THE HIDDEN ART ELEVATE YOUR VINYL EXPERIENCE WITH SCREEN-PRINTED B-SIDES AND D-SIDES

In a world dominated by digital convenience, vinyl records have resurfaced as a cherished symbol of artistry and tangible connection. As vinyl enthusiasts, we celebrate the warm analog sound and the aesthetic appeal of these spinning discs. However, there lies an inherent limitation that vinyl presents—the constrained duration of each side, leading to the occasional blank B-sides and D-sides. Yet, within this apparent limitation, a world of untapped potential awaits, and we, have set out on a journey to unleash the creativity concealed within these hidden canvases.

The Dilemma of Duration

Vinyl records have a unique charm, but they come with a spatial constraint. Traditionally, a standard 12-inch vinyl record can hold up to 20 to 22 minutes of music on each side. For shorter releases like EPs or singles, the A-side often houses the entire musical content, leaving the B-side seemingly vacant. Similarly, for lengthy albums that surpass the 40-minute mark, the music spills onto the C-side, rendering the D-side empty.

While this dilemma might have left some bands scratching their heads, we saw it as an opportunity to elevate the vinyl experience, giving rise to something truly special and rare in the world of records.

The Hidden Canvas

Instead of seeing the blank B-side and D-side as an inconvenience, we looked at them as blank canvases brimming with potential. The idea of screen-printing and etching on these hidden surfaces dawned upon us, and with a spark of inspiration, we began to create something extraordinary.

Unleashing Artistry: Screen-Printing on viny


After experimenting with different printing techniques we concluded that screen-printing gave the best results on vinyl and added an extra artisanal layer to the already very intensive process of manually pressing records here at dunk!pressing. It perfectly matches the approach of creating something with our hands, record after record, rather than using fully automated machines and losing actual touch with the product. To accomplish this we have some in-house specialists to test your ideas and guide you through the process, making sure the outcome is astonishing and adding up to the overall aesthetic of the album.


The Mesmerizing Charm of Etched Vinyl

As an alternative to this very intensive process of screen-printing every vinyl record we can also offer a more straight forward solution to be used on blank vinyl sides. Etched vinyl is being created by transferring a specific design to a stamper that would've been empty otherwise. This results in a vinyl record where one side has the grooves pressed into while at the same time the empty side has a beautiful design pressed onto it. This elevates the unintended empty side to a mesmerizing piece of art in one go.

Conclusion

What initially seems to be an inconvenient limitation to the vinyl medium can actually push the album to a new level when using the blank side as a hidden canvas to be used as an extension of the aesthetic ideas of the artist. What may have appeared as a "partial" package at first, transforms into a remarkably unique and special offering, where creativity knows no bounds.











AT DUNK!PRESSING WE ARE EQUIPPED TO OFFER A WIDE RANGE OF COLOR EFFECTS AS CRAZY AS YOU CAN IMAGINE, AND WE CAN DO IT ON ALL COMMON RECORD SIZES: 12", 10" AND 7".

Initially we only offered 180g 12" records for several reasons. First of all, the extra machine parts were expensive and it takes a lot of work and fine-tuning to set up the machine for different record sizes. However, we now have a few machines dedicated to sizes other than 12" 180g records, so we can easily schedule any other size production when we need to.

Originally we started as a pressing plant, offering custom made records for labels like our own. This meant that 12" 180g was the absolute quality standard we wanted to adhere to. However, as our business grew, we learned that other labels had their own aesthetics and philosophies, and theirs didn't necessarily have to be 12" and 180g.

These customers were looking for exceptional 10" releases, large runs of special colored 140g records, or a splattered 7" as a single release or to go with a 12" as a deluxe package. However, we have learned that these sizes are a valued part of the vinyl record universe.

We now have the equipment, skills and capacity to offer highly customized colored vinyl records on either 12" [140g and 180g], 10" and 7". With or without special packaging or a screen-printed B- or D-side. Because guess what; your EP will fit on a single sided 12" record, turning the now blank B-side into a screen-printed canvas for a visually stunning extra feature, adding even more value to your already spectacular release.

SUSTAINABLE VINYL PRESSING

In addition to spreading wonderful music around the world (literally), we are also trying to make the world a better place by minimizing our (and others') impact on the environment.

For starters, we moved our equipment into a new facility with a roof full of solar panels. So most of the electricity we need is generated by ourselves. When there's more solar power than we use in our facility, we put the excess power back into the grid. Having this power source allowed us to build a closed cooling system that uses very little water because it's a closed loop. The only place it might lose some water is when the valves on our machines are switching from steam to cooling water to cool the vinyl records being pressed. This (small amount of) water is not lost at all.

Together with the steam, this water goes back to a preheating tank where the condensate (i.e. the steam left over after pressing, which is still very hot) heats the water going into the steam boiler to about 90° to 100°C, so that it doesn't have to be heated from room temperature or even colder. To make this preheating even more efficient, we have also installed a system that recovers heat from the chimney so that nothing is lost. At night, we turn the steam down to about 40% capacity to keep the water warm until we start up again in the morning, so our system can easily get back up to temperature without wasting a lot of power to heat up from 0 to 40%. Of course, there's a point where it makes more sense to shut down completely and save more energy. We even schedule our production times to keep our system running at 100% for as long as possible and limit the number of starts from zero as much as possible.



REBOUND COMPOUND

When we talk about the environment, we also talk about waste management. And we'd like to introduce you to some of our dedicated and unique solutions. First of all, vinyl records are collectables. People cherish them and usually keep them for life. They don't get thrown away. Right? However, there is a certain amount of PVC waste in the production of vinyl records. Pressing a good vinyl record requires more compound than what ends up in the record. Also, quality control throws out a small amount of records that don't meet our quality standards. Because this waste is very homogeneous, we can easily sell it to a waste management company to be recycled. We choose not to shred it and use it to press other records because the quality risk is too high.

Wait a minute. Records are thrown away! Usually after decades and with scratches all over the surface. Useless for any turntable. Wrong again! We go and pick up these post-consumer records after they have had a wonderful life and brightened many other lives. But their song is not over. Well, actually it is, because we shred the records and turn them back into a granular compound to press many new songs onto vinyl records that sound as good (if not better!) as brand new virgin vinyl records. This is what we call our Black Rebound Compound. An environmentally friendly solution that doesn't sacrifice audio quality. Because all records deserve a second chance, scratched surface or not.







Over the years our company expanded in different directions. Simultaneously with building our pressing plant we also built a full sized recording studio, managed by two trained and experienced producers. This building houses two equipped studios, three rehearsing spaces, a small venue and accommodation for artist in residence or when recording in the studio. So basically we offer a one stop shop for every band. From your first rehearsal and album recording to vinyl pressing and release show.
